St. Joseph Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary March 19

This Thursday the Church celebrates the feast of St. Joseph the Worker. In Catholic traditions, Joseph is regarded as the patron saint of workers and is associated with various feast days. Pope Pius IX declared him to be both the patron and the protector of the Catholic Church, in addition to his patronages of the sick and of a happy death, due to the belief that he died in the presence of Jesus and Mary. In popular piety, Joseph is regarded as a model for fathers and has also become patron of various dioceses and places, as well as the patron of our sister parish in Waupun. He is also the patron of our men's group at Annunciation Parish.
